Community Housing Support Teams

(Mobile Residential Support Team & Residential Transitional Services Teams)

Locations: Medford & West Babylon

Job Function: To provide positive role model of community functioning, informal counseling and peer supports to others with psychiatric abilities currently living in scattered site supported housing program or those in preparation for more independent housing.

Qualifications: Personal experience in the mental health system. Mastery of basic ADL skills. Ability and desire to assist others in mastery of independent living skills. Understanding of peer support self-help philosophy, Clean valid NY State Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

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Mental Health Advocate (Part time)

Location: Patchogue

Job Function: Responsible for representing Federation with interfacing agencies at meetings and events and advocate for the needs of people in recovery from mental illness within the mental health system. Provide peer support, advocacy, education and information to staff, volunteers and program members. Facilitate peer support groups at designated hospitals.

Qualifications: Must identify as a person in recovery from a mental illness and willing to self-disclose their mental health journey in order to provide a message of hope and recovery. High School Diploma or equivalent. Peer Certification preferred Clean, valid N.Y. State driver's license. Fingerprinting, criminal record check and all necessary clearances from the Justice Center.

Location: *Suffolk County*

Job Function: Assist Case Managers by providing selected services to client. Accompany and/ or transport clients to various appointments. Demonstrate knowledge of benefits and how to access them such as SSI/SSD, and DSS. Teach clients ADL skills as well as use of public transportation, shopping and budgeting. Conduct occasional home or hospital visits. Model a behavior that empowers and shows a positive mental health recovery.

Qualifications: High School Diploma or Equivalent, NYS Driver's license. Registered, inspected, and insured vehicle, and personal experience with mental health system. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, approval from NYS Office of Mental Health
