- New York Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA) credential required

- Ability to work with clients, families, and staff in a caring and respectful manner, and with due understanding of and consideration for cultural differences
- Ability to be empathetic and supportive to client instructing, demonstrating, modeling, and encouraging appropriate behavior and skills
- Ability to do fieldwork at least 50% of the time
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Computer literate with basic proficiency in MS Word, Excel and Outlook
