RSS is seeking an individual to provide HCBS Services to individuals Delaware and/or Otsego Counties on a per diem basis. Home and Community Based Services include a variety of services that may be provided to an individual based on their goals and needs. This position is geared specifically toward the Peer Empowerment service. The qualified individual will be responsible for providing advocacy, outreach and engagement, promote and education on self-help tools, recovery support, and empowerment to individuals who qualify for these services. In addition, the individual will be responsible for the following:

- Once a referral is received, this individual will serve as the main point of contact for clients enrolled in one or more HCBS service
- The individual will be responsible for completing HCBS Peer Empowerment service assessments and HCBS Service Plans
- Provide the agreed upon services to the individual in their home or community
- Maintain the record per RSS standards
- Communicate as needed with all collateral contacts
- On-going communication with Care Managers and obtaining the Full Plan of Care from the Care Management agency once it is completed

Experience providing services in a community based setting, strong communication skills, ability to work independently and adapt to changes, computer skills, valid NYS Driver's License, and vehicle are required.
