The Role of Heredity in Mental and Substance Use Disorders



Dr. Glatt will describe research methods that are used to untangle the relative contributions of genes and environment (nature and nurture) to the development of mental illness and substance use disorders. Dr. Glatt will also review, in depth, the results that have emerged from applying those methods, from the earliest studies that merely showed that individual disorders run in families to the latest molecular genetic studies that pinpoint specific DNA molecules that concurrently raise risk for numerous disorders.
