CHWs and CRPAs are trusted, knowledgeable frontline health personnel who typically come from the communities they serve. CHWs and CRPAs bridge cultural and linguistic barriers, expand access to coverage and care, and improve health outcomes.

The **BCC** Program

- Prepares participants to work as CHWs and CRPAs.
- Meets the training requirements for NYS CRPA certification.
- Is a **FREE** program.

Upon completion, graduates will

- Be prepared to take the CRPA IC & RC certification exam
- Apply for CRPA certification with the New York Certification Board
- Have all CRPA certification and exam fees covered by the program
- Earn 9 credits towards a Public Health Administration Associate Degree at Bronx Community College
- Receive connections to employment opportunities!

- Have an annual income under \$30k
- Have a High School Diploma / TASC / GED
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be eligible to work in the U.S
- Have the passion and desire to guide and serve those in recovery
