NYC PEER CORPS

In 2017, NYC overdose deaths totaled 1,487—the highest number on record since the NYC Health Department (DOHMH) started tracking overdose deaths. The Peer Corps initiative was developed in response to the rising number of overdose deaths. The DOHMH, in partnership with other city agencies and nonprofits, recruits and mobilizes community members with lived experience in substance use and recovery, bringing life-saving services to marginalized populations throughout NYC.
