The Central Problem Gambling Resource Center (PGRC) is a program of the New York Council on Problem Gambling. The goal of the PGRC is to address problem gambling in the region by increasing public awareness about problem gambling, and connecting those adversely affected by gambling with services that can help them.

We increase public awareness by:

- Distributing materials about the PGRC and problem gambling;
- Conducting presentations and trainings specific to problem gambling for agencies and groups; and
- Meeting with community leaders like yourself to learn more about the community and its readiness to address problem gambling.

We connect individuals and families to help by:

- Increasing access to treatment services via a private practitioner network made up of licensed mental health clinicians who are trained and willing to help those affected by problem gambling; and
- Giving 1:1 attention and support to those seeking assistance, and connecting them with the services and support they need.

What can you do to join the effort?

- ⇒ Invite PGRC staff to conduct a presentation or training with your staff.
- ⇒ Talk with the PGRC about problem gambling in your community.

Clinicians can...

- ⇒ Sign up to be a part of our Clinical Network.
