



Exercise your right as an American citizen and register to vote.

Friday, October 9, 2020 is the last day to register to vote and last day to postmark applications for the General Election. Postmarked applications must be received by a board of elections no later than October 14, 2020 to be eligible to vote in the General Election.

You can register to vote online, by mail, or in person at your local Board of Elections on any business day on or before **October 9, 2020**. If honorably discharged from the U.S. Military or you have become a naturalized US Citizen as of October 9, 2020, you may register in person at your county Board of Elections through October 24, 2020.

To register to vote online you will need to:

- Go to <https://voterreg.dmv.ny.gov/MotorVoter/> and provide the following:
 - NYS driver license, permit, or non-driver ID card
 - ZIP Code currently on record with the DMV
 - Social security number

To register to vote without a license you will need to:

- Print and fill out the voter registration from found at https://www.elections.ny.gov/NYSBOE/download/voting/voteform_enterable.pdf
- Send the application or deliver it in person to your County Board of Elections

Voting by Mail

Once you are registered to vote you can apply for an absentee ballot mail, online, email or fax no later **October 27, 2020**. You may apply in-person up to the day before the election November 2, 2020.

How to Cast an Absentee Ballot:

- Once you receive your ballot, mark the ballot according to your choices for each office following the instructions on the ballot
- Once you have completed marking your ballot fold it up and place it in the Security Envelope. (This envelope will have a place for your signature.)
- Sign and date the outside of the Security Envelope.
- Seal the Security Envelope.
- Place the Security Envelope in the Return Envelope. (This envelope will have the return address of your county Board of Elections on the outside and should have a logo that reads, "Official Election Mail")
- Seal the Return Envelope.
- You may return the ballot in any of the following ways:
 - Put it in the mail ensuring it receives a postmark no later than November 3rd.
 - Bringing it to the County Board of Elections Office no later than November 3rd by 9pm.
 - Bringing it to an early voting poll site between October 24th and November 1st
 - Bringing it to a poll site on November 3rd by 9pm.
